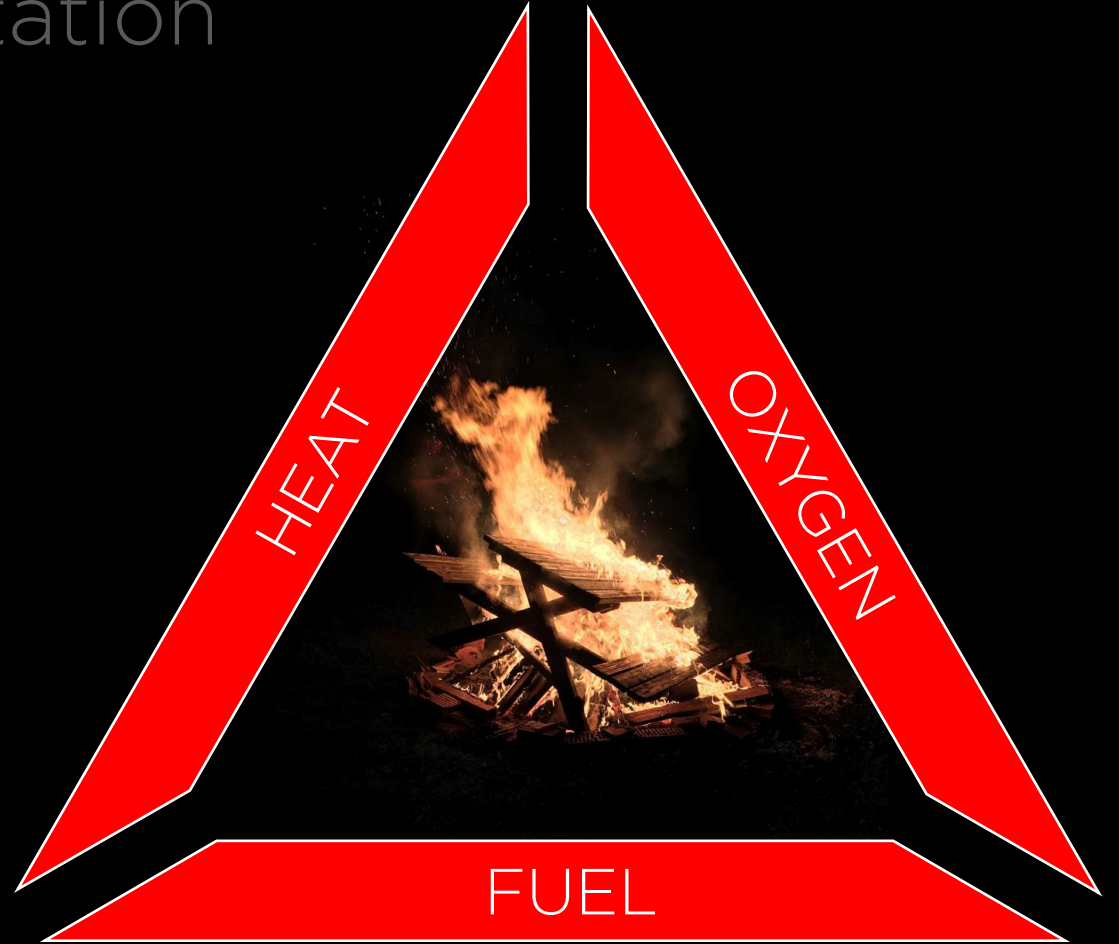


3 Ingredients To Set Stuff Ablaze

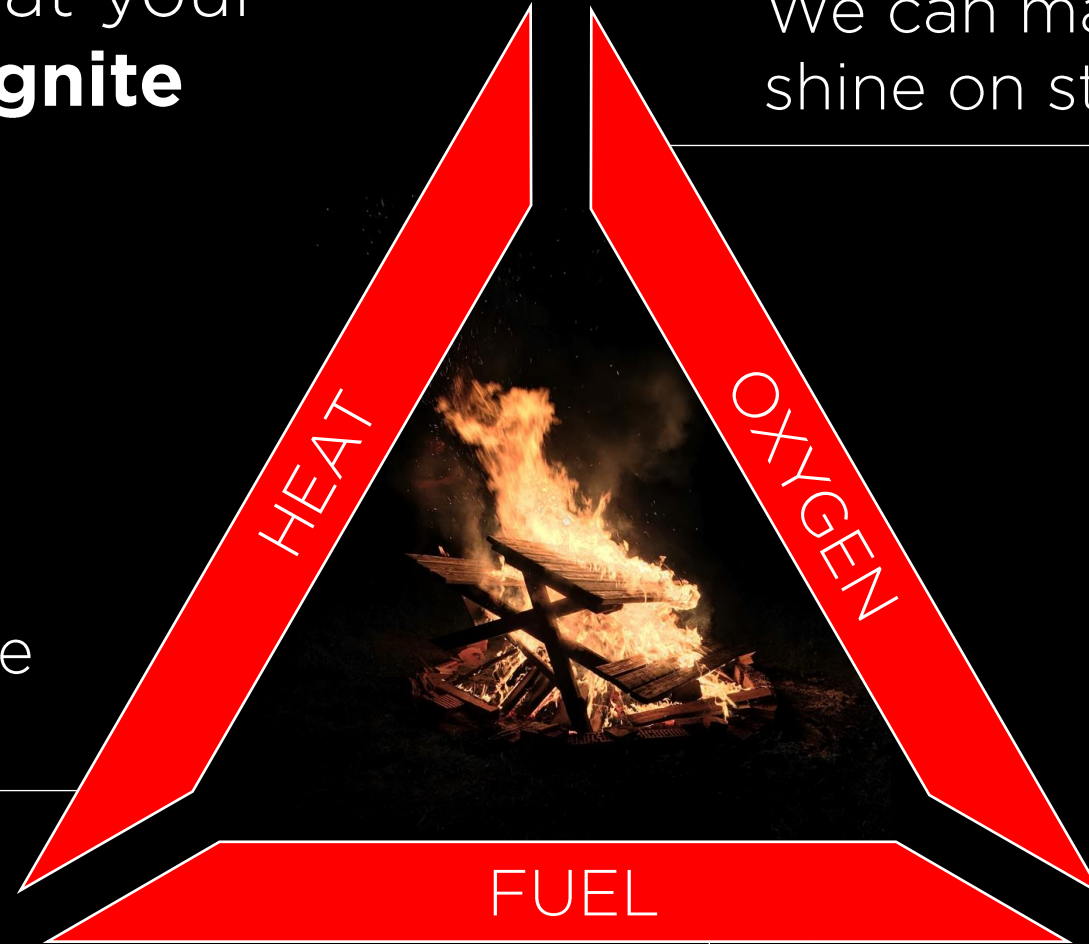
